Board members were encouraged to continue working on the GCBA Road Map (a month-by-month to do list) and submit their duties/responsibilities to Janice who will coordinate this project. This project will help to direct future club leaders in the nuts and bolts operation of GCBA.

The order will be for various items for the Field Day and Courtesy Items for the membership such as bottom boards (15 medium and 35 deep), 2 boxes of pollen patties, and pollinator seeds.
